November 16, 2009

World History I – Read “The Taj Mahal” primary source and answer the questions on the worksheet itself. Also, study for tomorrow’s essay test (unlike all previous ones...). The best way to prepare – review the major beliefs and practices of Islam. Be prepared to “explain” Islam to someone who knows *nothing* about it.

US History (Honors) B – Begin the “My America Project”.

November 17, 2009

World History I – Read Chapter 13, sect. 1 (pp.317-321) and do WKBK p.46. Expect a quiz!!

US History (Honors) A – Read Ch.17 (complete part D and F on the study guide worksheet). Also, read the “Seneca Falls Declaration of Rights” attached to the back of the outline. Highlight or star those items similar to the Declaration of Independence. EXPECT A QUIZ!! So, read!!!

November 18, 2009

World History I – Read Chapter 13, sect. 2 Complete #1 and #2 of the section review on p.326. 3rd Block – study your SOL outline on the Middle Ages in preparation for a quiz.

US History (Honors) B – Read Ch.17 (complete part D and F on the study guide worksheet). Also, read the “Seneca Falls Declaration of Rights” attached to the back of the outline. Highlight or star those items similar to the Declaration of Independence. EXPECT A QUIZ!! So, read!!!

November 19, 2009

World History I – Read Chapter 13, sect. 3 (No assigned written work – it would be wise to take notes...)

US History (Honors) A – Complete the “Manifest Destiny” Project.

November 20, 2009

World History I (Honors) – Read “The Prince” through Chapter 10 (p.47)

World History (3rd Block) – Begin work on your project as identified in your syllabus. Your due date will be December 4th.

US History (Honors) B – Complete the “Manifest Destiny” Project.
