

EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY

The School Board values hard work and honesty and views school as the work of youth. In achieving its primary mission, the Board is committed to graduating young adults who will be prepared to continue their learning and be competent workers, become good citizens, and live productive and fulfilled lives.

It shall be the policy of the School Board to:

Provide the necessary trained and dedicated leadership, qualified personnel, equipment and materials to assure an appropriate education for every student;

Treat all personnel equitably with the highest degree of respect;

Appropriate funds fairly and efficiently; and

Attend to the property and equipment of all schools to work toward achieving parity among schools in the division.
