<u>Title:</u> What is a Map? by Lauren Weidenman	
<u>Before Reading:</u> -Predict and Preview Selection -Ask for and/or provide background knowledge -Vocabulary instruction/preview (if needed for unknown words) -Discuss Words to Know/Index section of book	
<u>During Reading:</u> - Students will read silently. -Listen to Individual Reader <u>Guiding Questions</u> - Read pages two through five. - What is a map ? (RRJ) - Share responses. - Read pages six and seven. - Answer the question at the bottom of page 7. (RRJ) - Share responses. - Read pages eight and nine. - Does the map of a place have to be the same size as the place? (RRJ) - Share responses. - Read pages ten and eleven. - What is the difference between a compass rose and a compass ? (RRJ) - Draw a compass rose. (RRJ) - Share responses. - Read pages twelve and thirteen. - Do you know another term for a map key? What is it? (RRJ) - Share responses. - Read pages fourteen through sixteen. - How have you used a map? (RRJ) - Share responses.
