

Guided Reading Lesson

Grade Level: Kindergarten	SOL:
<u>Title:</u> Kinds of Weather	
<u>Before Reading:</u> -Predict and Preview Selection: During picture walk, discuss the clothing that each child is wearing and the different activities that take place in different types of weather. -Ask for and/or provide background knowledge: Ask students what they already know about different types of weather. -Vocabulary instruction/preview (if needed for unknown words): rainy, sunny, snowy, windy, cloudy	
<u>During Reading:</u> <u>Word Work:</u> Identify and read correctly the high frequency words it and is. <u>Vocabulary:</u> look at each picture while reading to match the rebus with the picture. -Listen to Individual Reader-Model the book by reading aloud. Encourage student s to read independently <u>Guiding Questions</u> What activities do you do in different kinds of weather? What clothing/accessories do you need in different kinds of weather?	
<u>After Reading:</u> - <u>Reading Response Journal:</u> Draw and write about an activity that you like to do when there is a certain kind of weather. - <u>Re-telling/Comprehension activities:</u> Bring in a picture of you doing something outside during a weather situation. Share with classmates your picture and sort all pictures according to the weather situation.
